New route for 2025



The 45th annual edition of the London Marathon takes place on Sunday 27 April 2025 and will require road closures and parking restrictions in your area.

More than 50,000 participants will take on the 26.2-mile course, which starts in Greenwich, crosses Tower Bridge and travels through Canary Wharf before finishing on The Mall in Westminster.

Road closures

So the event can go ahead safely, roads will be closed in Canary Wharf from 08:00 to 20:30 on Sunday 27 April 2025.

This year, the course will use several different roads in Canary Wharf, including Montgomery Street, Water Street and Charter Street. Please see the map of the new route over the page.

Parking restrictions

Any vehicles parked on the route will be removed from 04:00 on Sunday 27 April.

Please assist us by moving your vehicle off the route on the evening of Saturday 26 April. If your vehicle is relocated by event contractors, please visit **trace.london** to find it.
